## **LOCAL RULES APPENDIX**

---

### **First see Conditions of Competition and Local Rules in the Hard Card**

#### **1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27):**

- a) Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes and white lines.
- b) Inner out of bounds between holes Nr. 7 and Nr. 8 is defined only when playing hole Nr. 7. When playing hole Nr. 8 white stakes are defined as immovable obstructions.
- c) Inner out of bounds between holes Nr. 13 and Nr. 14 are marked by red stakes with white heads and red lines (lateral water hazards) and are defined only when playing hole Nr. 13. When playing hole Nr. 14 red stakes with the white head are defined as movable obstructions.

#### **2. Water hazards (Rule 26):**

Lateral water hazards are marked by red stakes and red lines.

#### **3. The red sandy areas (Waste Area):**

The sandy areas with the red sand described as Waste Areas are deemed to be „through the green“ and players may ground their club and remove loose impediments.

#### **4. Wrong Putting Green**

The makeshift putting green has the status of the wrong putting green, the player MUST take relief under Rule 25-3

#### **5. Preferred Lies (Appendix I - 3b)**

A ball lying **on a closely-mown area** through the green may be lifted, without penalty, and cleaned. Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, he must place it on a spot within one score card length of and not nearer the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.
