

APPENDIX TO LOCAL RULES

First see Conditions of Competition and permanent Local Rules in „Hard Card“.

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27):

- a) Out of Bound is marked by a fence, white stakes or white line.
- b) Inner out of bounds between holes Nr. 4/7 and 14/15 is defined only when playing holes Nr. 7 or Nr. 14, When playing the other holes white stakes are defined as immovable obstructions.

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26):

Water hazards and lateral water hazards are defined by yellow or red stakes and yellow or red lines.

3. Integral Part of The Course

The stones indicating the distance to holes.

4. Ground Under Repair

- a) Everything from the definitions of the Rules and the Hard Card and places marked by blue stakes and white closed lines.
- b) Exposed roots left by green on hole Nr. 11

5. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

- a) Tree Basins with stones.
- b) The paths with any surface.

6. Dropping Zones

If a ball is in a position known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the water hazard when playing the hole Nr. 17 the player may

- a) proceed under Rule 26-1; or
- b) as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone on the right by the path.
